## Local Days 2022 – Get Proposal Development Trainings for DIGITbrain Open Call!

Proposal development for H2020 Innovation Actions can pose a huge challenge to manufacturing SMEs. DIGITbrain's Digital Innovation Hubs therefore conceived a series of special proposal development trainings for those who want to apply in the 2<sup>nd</sup> DIGITbrain Open Call.

DIGITbrain Local Days are designed to meet the specific needs of manufacturing companies, giving them a special training on the application procedure. The events will be provided by DIGITbrain's Digital Innovation Hubs in their respective national language to lower entrance barriers for interested parties.

The participation in Local Days is not mandatory for a successful application in the DIGITbrain Open Call, however, a participation is highly recommended to master the application process!

The training workshops will have a duration of 50-60 minutes and be available in English, Italian, Spanish, Hungarian, Finnish, and Danish to make it easier for you to understand what's expected from you regarding the application process.

The fact, that languages workshops are only offered in six languages, however, does not mean that you cannot apply for the Open Call if your language is not covered. All manufacturing companies (SME) or technology providers (SME) that are in the EU, a Horizon 2020 associated country or the UK, can apply in DIGITbrain's Open Call, open from 28<sup>th</sup> of February to 31<sup>st</sup> of May 2022. If there is no workshop in your language, we would like to encourage you to choose the best alternative option for you.

DIGITbrain Project supports application experiments to build a digital twin to solve an industrial problem in manufacturing. Selected experiments will be supported with up to 97.800 Euros and can cover all segments of the entire manufacturing sector, e.g., discrete manufacturing, continuous production, or construction. Submit your experiment proposal until the 31st of May!
